### Mailman Control Panel

Parameter	Value	Description
your domainname	<input type="text" value="http://tech.groups.yahc"/>	What domainname does mailman use? (Go to your Mailman listinfo page and enter the EXACT domain name you see just after the http://. Only enter the domain name, not the /listinfo part. The most common mistake is including the www. if Mailman doesn't use it.)
your admin directory	<input type="text" value="http://tech.groups.yahc"/>	Most sites do not have to change this. It should be set to the directory just after the domain name. By default, "/mailman/admin". Some hosted sites have it as "/admin.cgi"
Appended Domain	<input type="text"/>	When using shared hosting services, the real list name is often the basic listname with your domain appended to it. For example, if the mailing list address is listname@domain.com, the REAL Mailman listname is listname_domain.com. If this was the case for you, you would see that appended domain in the listinfo and admin pages. If thats the way your site works, put the phrase appended to your list names here (e.g. _domain.com)
Sitename	<input type="text" value="MyJoomla"/>	Descriptive name of your website as you would use it in a sentence.
ListAdmin password	<input type="text"/>	What password do you use when you login to the Mailman administrative interface? (This must currently be set to the same value for all lists you want this component to work with.)
Sender email	<input type="text" value="noreply@domain.com"/>	This component will send an email to each user who uses it. Which email address would you like that email to come from? (noreply@my-domain.com)
External Lists	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	(Almost all will leave this set to No.) This component has a section that can display subscription instructions for external mailing lists. If you wish to use this, you can set this to yes and edit mailman2.php.
Debug Status	<input type="checkbox"/>	Set this to Yes to turn on debug information. (Only necessary if troubleshooting.)
